Job Description:

1 | POSITION PURPOSE: The winch truck driver is responsible for the safe hauling, moving, loading and unloading of a client's oilfield tools, equipment etc, to rig or camp sites.

2 | MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Operate straight and articulated trucks in a safe manner and maintain a safety first orientation in all that is done,
- Perform pre and post trip inspections of load and vehicle, position equipment for loading and unloading,
- May operate winches and gin poles to load and unload equipment
- Ensures loads and rigging are secure,
- Inspect truck for defects and safe operating condition, before, during and after trips,
- Install and remove tire chains as required by road and weather conditions,
- Perform his duties in accordance to DOT guidelines / rules,
- Report road safety hazards noted on route and equipment safety issues reported,
- Coordinate with the Dispatcher on delivery, breakdowns, weather, traffic conditions, etc.
- Complete Driver Logs accurately and on time,
- Working knowledge and compliance with relevant regulations and legislation,
- Trains Swampers, mentors new Drivers.
- Participates in training and Company safety processes.
